Appropriate Assessment Determination

Variation No 4 Meath County Development Plan 2013-2019

The purpose of Variation No. 4 of the County Development Plan is to facilitate the implementation of the requirements arising from the Urban Regeneration and Housing Act 2015 as they relate to the introduction of the Vacant Site Levy.

Having regard to the recommendation contained in the report '*Provision of information to support screening for appropriate assessment of Variation no. 4 of the Meath County Development Plan 2013-2019*' prepared by Scott Cawley, College House, Rock Road, Blackrock, Co. Dublin, Appropriate Assessment of the proposed variation is not required as it can be excluded, on the basis of objective information, that the proposed variation individually or in combination with other plans or projects, will not have a significant effect on any European sites.

Based on the above recommendation it is considered that Meath County Council can determine that there are no likely significant effects of the implementation of Variation No. 4 independently and in combination with other plans and projects on any designated site.
